

LUNG CANCER SCREENING PROGRAM

DO YOU QUALIFY?

- Age: 50 to 80 years old (50 to 77 for Medicare)
- A current smoker or have quit smoking within the past 15 years
- Have at least a 20 pack-year smoking history (at least one pack per day for 20 years or two packs per day for 10 years)
- Have no new symptoms that could be related to lung cancer
- Healthy enough to tolerate curative intent treatment for early-stage lung cancer and have not had a chest CT in the last 12 months

SYMPTOMS

Blood when you cough or spit

Recurring respiratory infections

nduring cough that is new or different

A che or pain in shoulder, back, or chest

rouble breathing

oarseness or wheezing

Exhaustion, weakness, or loss of appetite
